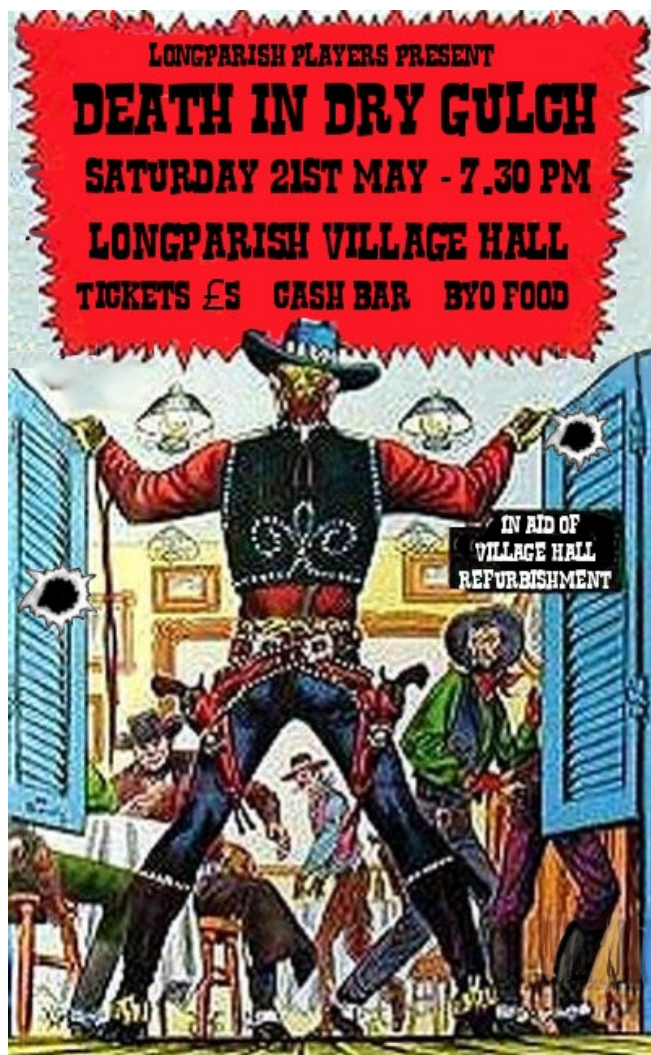


Death in Dry Gulch - Murder Mystery - Sat 21 May
